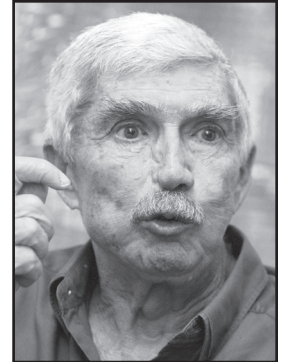


# Protest in El Paso

## Extradite the Terrorist Luis Posada Carriles!

Come to the Federal Courthouse in downtown El Paso, Texas for a peaceful protest. Tell the U.S. government to stop protecting terrorist Luis Posada Carriles. Posada is the mastermind behind the 1976 bombing of a Cuban airliner, which killed 73 people, and the bombing of Cuban hotels in 1997, which killed one person and injured many.

## Justice for his Victims!

Luis Posada Carriles is an international terrorist trained by the CIA at Ft. Benning, GA (site of the infamous School of the Americas) in the early 1960s. For decades he has done the CIA's dirty work against Cuba and Latin American social movements.

On March 1, Luis Posada Carriles goes on trial in El Paso, Texas. He is being charged with perjury for lying to U.S. officials about his role in the bombings of several Havana hotels. However, the U.S. government refuses to prosecute or extradite Posada for his terrorist acts, even though there is substantial evidence of his role in:

**1) 1997 hotel bombings in Havana:** Posada paid mercenaries to fly to Cuba and plant bombs in hotels. Italian tourist Fabio Di Celmo was killed by one of those bombs; many others were injured. Posada later bragged to New York Times reporters of his role.

**2) Oct. 6, 1976 bombing of a Cuban civilian airliner:** Posada and his accomplice Orlando Bosch paid mercenaries to board Cubana Flight 455 headed to Cuba from Venezuela, via Barbados. The mercenaries planted two bombs and exited in Barbados. The plane exploded mid-flight; 73 passengers and crew were killed. Venezuela filed an extradition request for Posada with the U.S. in June 2005, shortly after he illegally entered the U.S., but both Presidents George W. Bush and Barack Obama refuse to honor the extradition order.

At the protest, **we will also demand freedom for the Cuban Five**, five Cuban men unjustly imprisoned by the U.S. government since Sept. 12, 1998. Their mission was to monitor the activities of U.S.-backed terrorists like Posada. Yet, despite the Cuban Five's life-saving mission, they are in U.S. prison while terrorist Posada Carriles runs free in Miami.
